

The Cornerstone Allocation Process

The Cornerstone allocation process is an optimum fit between a puppy and a forever home.

Here at Cornerstone Labradoodles, we have an extensive application process to assist us to get to know a future family or individual as they begin the search for their puppy. At 6 weeks we evaluate the puppies and determine their temperaments and personalities. After that point, we match puppies to the families on our litter reservation list. This process helps us ensure a successful experience for both the puppy and the family for the life of the puppy.

When a family visits a puppy to pick, that family is only seeing a brief “snapshot” of a puppy’s life. It is one hour segment in time, and is not an accurate description of the puppy. We observe the pups day in and day out from birth onwards, a puppy may look calm and cuddly, but this could be because they just spent an hour running and playing, or they may look active and playful because they just woke up from a nap...they could also look disinterested simply because they are tired.....No one can accurately assess a puppy from one moment in time any more than you can accurately assess a person in that manner. We have the benefit of being with our puppies 24 hours a day, they are raised in our home, we handle and care for them daily, we touch them multiple times a day from birth on, we have a total and completely different perspective than a person coming by for a quick visit.

To be considered for a Cornerstone puppy, please understand that you will not choose a puppy, a puppy will be placed based on temperament and personality, not based on their looks.
